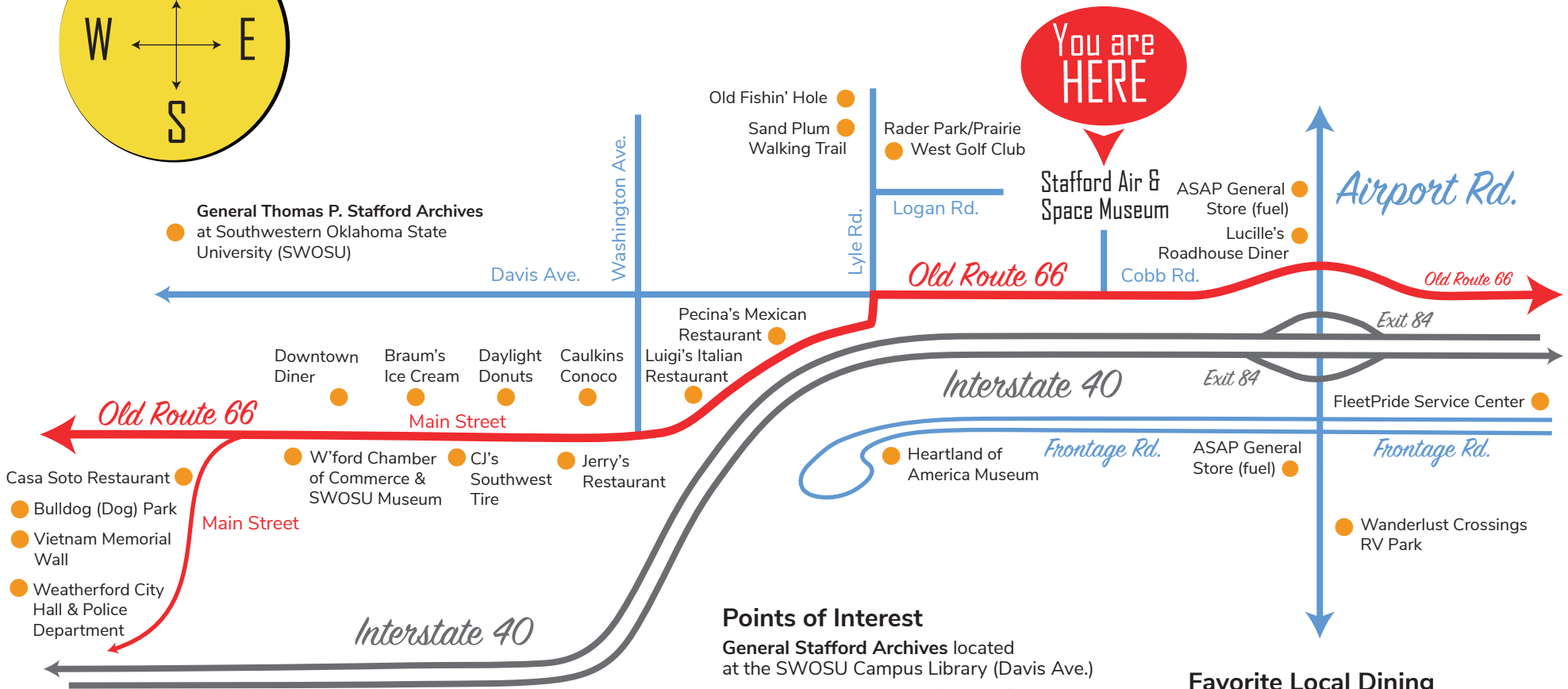
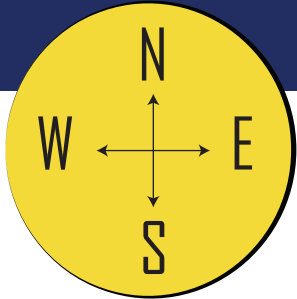

About The Museum

The Stafford Air & Space Museum is named in honor of Weatherford native and legendary test pilot and astronaut, Lt. General Thomas P. Stafford. The museum is considered one of the finest and most comprehensive air and space museums in the central United States and encompasses 63,000 sq. ft. of exhibits under one roof!

Museum Location: Along Route 66 at I-40 and Exit 84 in Weatherford, OK

Museum Schedule and Operating Hours: Open seven days a week, 360 days a year (Closed Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, and Easter). We are open **Monday thru Saturday from 9am-5pm and Sundays from 1pm-5pm.**

About The General

General Thomas P. Stafford was born and raised in Weatherford, OK. His mother came to Oklahoma in a covered wagon and lived to see her only child fly to the moon. His father was a dentist who taught his son to appreciate what he had by working hard for it. Tom found a love for heights at age 4, when he climbed his first windmill and was certain he was on top of the world. Through a lot of hard work and natural abilities, Tom would make his way to the top 10% at the U.S. Naval Academy, become a 3-star General in the U.S. Air Force, and be known as the first astronaut to become a General and the first General to fly in space. General Stafford has worked for NASA, the Pentagon, and Area 51, and is responsible for Stealth Technology as we know it today. He still holds the record for fastest man alive, 24,791 mph, on his re-entering the Earth in Apollo 10. He and his best friend, Alexei Leonov (Russian Cosmonaut), were the beginning of the end of the Cold War. You will learn this and much more as you venture through our museum. We are so proud of the one we represent.
